PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, I, Jeanne P. Atkins, Secretary of State of the State of Oregon, on July 21, 2016, pursuant to law, canvassed the votes for and against a recall question submitted to the voters of Harney County at a special recall election held on June 28, 2016, as shown by the official abstracts of votes filed with me by the Harney County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, according to this canvass, the whole number of votes cast in the Harney County for and against such question at the special recall election on June 28, 2016, was as follows:

SHALL Steven E Grasty, Harney County Judge , BE RECALLED?

Yes - 830


No - 1969

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jeanne P. Atkins, Secretary of State of the State of Oregon, issue this proclamation to the people of the State of Oregon and announce and declare that the whole number of votes cast in Harney County at the special recall election on June 28, 2016, for and against the question was as previously stated, and that the question did not receive an affirmative majority of the total number of votes cast.

Therefore, the public officer is not recalled as provided in Article II, Section 18, of the Oregon Constitution.
