

# Absentee Ballot Request Form

for currently registered Oregon voters who will be away during an election

## instructions

If you are going to be away during an election but would still like to vote, you can request an absentee ballot. The post office will not forward your ballot from your home address, so you must request an absentee ballot in order to vote. Possible reasons for requesting an absentee ballot include:

- you will be on vacation during an election
- you are a college student living away from home
- you live part of the year in another state (e.g. snow bird)
