Court House Drive-Up Ballot Box Relocated for Convenience

The official 24-hour drive up ballot box at the courthouse has been relocated to the South side of the rear parking lot. With construction pending on the heating system in the building, we saw the need to keep the box accessible for upcoming elections occurring during the construction phase. **Please access the box from the Washington Street entrance to the parking lot, turning immediately left up to the box, and exit onto Court Street.**

Additional official 24-hour dropsites are available at Hines City Hall, and across from the Fellowship church in Crane. Official limited-hour dropsites are located inside the Harney County Library, Harney County Senior Center, and the Harney County Clerk's office.

Ballots for the Primary Election will begin arriving in mail boxes on or after April 28th. The last day to register or update your party affiliation for the Primary is April 26th. You can do so on-line at www.oregonvotes.gov, or in person at the Harney County Clerk's office.

Ballots are due back to the County Clerk's office or in an official ballot dropsite no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, May 17th. Post-marks don't count, so we urge you not to mail your ballot after May 10th, but to use an official ballot dropsite.
