Job Duties: Follow Public Health Department programs, protocols, policies and standing orders, including communicable disease, family planning, WIC, Babies First, CaCoon, Maternity Case Management, HIV, Immunization, and BCC. Assess, plan and evaluate individual needs and family needs. Implement nursing services in a planned health program. Make home, office or clinic visits. Exchange information with physicians, other health workers and agencies for more effective care of the individual. Arrange or conduct classes or group meetings with community groups. Maintain records for services and make reports as required. Follow all rules of professional ethics, HIPAA and confidentiality regulations. Follow all safety rules and procedures for work areas.
