POSSESSION OF ALCOHOL BY A MINOR

FIRST OFFENSE

FORMAL ACCOUNTABILITY AGREEMENT

- 1. Formal Accountability Agreement except in extenuating circumstances.
- 2. 40 hours of community service as directed by the Juvenile Department.
- 3. Pay \$40.00 probation supervision fee.
- 4. Complete a state approved Alcohol and Drug Assessment, at Symmetry Care, under the direction of the Juvenile Department and at the expense of the youth and parent(s)guardian. The youth and his/her parents will follow the recommendations of the evaluator. Application to Symmetry Care must be made prior to next scheduled status conference.
- 5. Participate in a Victim Impact Panel as directed by the Juvenile Department and be responsible for the cost.
- 6. The youth shall surrender driving privileges to the Juvenile Department for a minimum period of 90 days (3 months) and maximum of 1 year.
- 7. Submit to testing of breath or urine for controlled substance or alcohol use if there is reasonable suspicion that the youth has used alcohol or controlled substances.
- 8. 8:00 pm to 6:00 am Curfew, subject to a 30-day review.

SECOND OFFENSE

JUVENILE COURT HEARING

- 1. 80 hours of community service as directed by the Juvenile Department.
- 2. Pay \$15.00 Probation Supervision fee monthly
- 3. Pay \$37.00 Unitary Assessment fee.
- 4. Complete a state approved Alcohol and Drug Assessment, under the direction of the Juvenile Department and at the expense of the youth and parent(s)guardian. The youth and his/her parents will follow the recommendations of the evaluator. Application into an approved program must be made prior to next scheduled status conference.
- 5. Driver's License suspension under ORS 809.260.
- 6. Submit to testing of breath or urine for controlled substance or alcohol use if there is reasonable suspicion that the youth has used alcohol or controlled substances.
- 7. Participate in a Victim Impact Panel as directed by the Juvenile Department and be responsible for the cost.
- 8. 8:00 pm to 6:00 am Curfew, subject to a 30-day review.

THIRD AND SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES

JUVENILE COURT HEARING

- 1. 120 hours of community service as directed by the Juvenile Department.
- 2. Pay \$15.00 monthly Probation Supervision fee.
- 3. Pay \$37.00 Unitary Assessment fee.
- 4. Complete a state approved Alcohol and Drug Assessment, under the direction of the Juvenile Department and at the expense of the youth and parent(s)guardian. The youth and his/her parents will follow the recommendations of the evaluator. Application into an approved program must be made prior to next scheduled status conference
- 5. Driver's License suspension under ORS 809.260.
- 6. Submit to testing of breath or urine for controlled substance or alcohol use if there is reasonable suspicion that the youth has used alcohol or controlled substances.
- 7. Participate in a Victim Impact Panel as directed by the Juvenile Department and be responsible for the cost.
- 9. 6:00 pm to 6:00 am Curfew, subject to a 30-day review.

UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA BY A JUVENILE

FIRST OFFENSE

FORMAL ACCOUNTABILITY AGREEMENT

- 1. Formal Accountability Agreement except in extenuating circumstances.
- 2. Complete a state approved Alcohol and Drug Assessment, at Symmetry Care, under the direction of the Juvenile Department and at the expense of the youth and parent(s)guardian. The youth and his/her parents will follow the recommendations of the evaluator. Application into Symmetry Care must be made prior to next scheduled status conference.
- 3. 40 hours Community Service hours or more, to be set by the Juvenile Department.
- 4. Pay \$40.00 probation supervision fee.
- 5. The youth shall surrender driving privileges to the Juvenile Department for a period of 90 days (3 months). The driver's license may be returned to the youth when all conditions of probation have been met.
- 6. Abide by a 8:00pm to 6:00am curfew (Subject to a 30 day review)
- 7. Submit to testing of breath or urine for controlled substance or alcohol use if there is reasonable suspicion that the youth has used alcohol or controlled substances.
- 8. Tell where the marijuana came from.

UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF MARIJUANA BY A JUVENILE

SECOND AND SUBSEQUENT OFFENSES

JUVENILE COURT HEARING

- 1. 80 hours of community service.
- 2. Complete a state approved Alcohol and Drug Assessment, under the direction of the Juvenile Department and at the expense of the youth and parent(s)guardian. The youth and his/her parents will follow the recommendations of the evaluator. Application into an approved program must be made prior to next scheduled status conference.
- 3. \$15.00 probation supervision fee monthly.
- 4. Pay \$37.00 Unitary Assessment fee.
- 5. Driver's License suspension under ORS 809.260.
- 6. 8:00 pm to 6:00 am Curfew, subject to a 30-day review.
- 7. Tell where the marijuana came from.

POSSESSION OF TOBACCO BY A JUVENILE

FIRST OFFENSE

(OPTIONAL) <u>REFER TO TEEN COURT</u> DIVERSION AGREEMENT

Failure to comply with Teen Court sentence or the Diversion Agreement, the youth will be referred back to the Juvenile Department

SECOND OFFENSE

FORMAL ACCOUNTABILITY AGREEMENT

- 1. 20 hours of community service as directed by the Juvenile Department.
- 2. Pay \$40.00 Probation Supervision fee.
- 3. Complete a Tobacco Education class at private expense with a certified counselor approved by the Juvenile Department.

THIRD OFFENSE

JUVENILE COURT HEARING

- 1. 40 hours of community service as directed by the Juvenile Department.
- 2. Pay \$15.00 Probation Supervision fee per month.
- 3. Pay \$37.00 Unitary Assessment fee.
- 4. Complete a state approved Alcohol and Drug Assessment, under the direction of the Juvenile Department and at the expense of the youth and parent(s)guardian. The youth and his/her parents will follow the recommendations of the evaluator. Application into an approved program must be made prior to next scheduled status conference.
