PURPOSE OF POSITION:

Perform a variety of home visiting nursing duties. Provide health/wellness services, including referral services for mothers and children in our community. Assess the needs of mothers and their children, and determine a plan to meet these needs. Implement or help implement this plan, with support from the Director and Community Health Worker.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

Responsible for providing population based, comprehensive nursing services to pregnant, post-partum, and parenting women and their families.
Use Program models: Babies First and CaCoon.
Promote positive health behavior and educate the public and patient on health conditions and health maintenance.
Plan and provide home visits to women and their families when they are pregnant, post-partum, and or parenting.
Provide nursing care and case management services.
Reach out to women who are eligible for both programs.
Comply with Oregon and Babies First/CaCoon core competencies for efficient home visiting services, including completing training for each program, and keep up with current trends in the field.
Work with the Director and CHW in promoting these programs, and remain in contact with professional colleagues throughout the state who work in these programs to learn up-to-date practices.
Assess the emotional, physical, social, and mental needs of the women and their families. Assist them through education, support, and referral services to meet their targeted goals.
Provide Targeted Case Management billing for eligible families.
Promote each program throughout the community, including going to community events to show the services offered and meet with providers and potential mothers.
Schedule home visits and manage workload.
Meet with supervisor weekly to discuss program and activities.
Maintain records of plans and service.
Follow all rules of professional ethics, HIPAA, and confidentiality regulations.
