PURPOSE OF POSITION:

Perform a wide variety of skilled maintenance duties to ensure the proper safety operation and functionality of facilities at the Harney County Fairgrounds. Perform related work as seasonally required. Customer service.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

1. Maintain functional use of the Fairgrounds:
2. Ensure safety and operational status of facilities for Grounds, Arena, Building, RV park, Stalls and Barns
3. Perform any necessary repairs to ensure the safety and operations of facilities, this may include but is not limited to basic carpentry, electrical, plumbing, metal work and painting.
4. Operate and maintain grounds maintenance equipment which includes, but is not limited to, the wheel line, hoses, sprinklers, rakes, push and riding mower, weed eater, and herbicide sprayers to maintain general appearance of the grounds.
5. Remove snow and Ice from all parking areas and walkaways before and during events if needed.
6. Provide friendly customer service to all guests of the grounds.
7. Attend work as scheduled and/or required
8. Office-Perform reception duties as needed, such as answer phones. Help with PR work including, but not limited to, hanging posters and banners. Document maintenance projects in an organized manner. Map infrastructure and keep updated maps available for infrastructure needs in coordination with the Fair Manager.
